


About The Program

This initiative was made possible through the collective efforts that raised \$95,000 to fund the BOGO offer.

The response to our BOGO program exceeded expectations. Within a mere **2.5 hours**, we sold out of bonus dollars, guaranteeing **\$190,000** to flow back into our local businesses.

\$205,000 worth of gift cards were purchased during this time, displaying a resounding commitment to supporting our local economy. It is worth noting that every cent of revenue generated goes directly back into bolstering our community.




Marketing Plan
