We have create two key areas to support Minority, Women, and Veteran Owned Businesses.

#### 1 Education Programming

We have created a two part series. The first is educating businesses on if they should become certified, if they qualify, and if it something they are willing to do. Below are the four key morning programs:

- 1. What is an XBE Business and are you one?
- 2. Learn more about Minority & Women Owned Certification
- 3. Learn more about Veteran Owned Certification
- 4. You are Certified now what? Understanding what's next.



### The Course - 6 Part Series



This six-week workshop series on becoming State of Indiana Minority, Women, and Veteran Enterprise (MWVE) certified provides prospective XBE businesses with information and guidance on the certification process to become a certified MWVE supplier in the state of Indiana. The workshop will cover the following key areas:

#### 1 Introduction to MWVE certification

Participants are introduced to the MWVE certification program and its significance in promoting diversity and inclusion in state procurement. They learn about the benefits of certification, such as increased access to contracting opportunities and networking resources.

#### (2) Eligibility criteria

The workshop covers the eligibility requirements for MWVE certification, including the definition of minority, women, and veteran-owned businesses. Participants learn about the necessary documentation and qualifications they need to meet to be considered for certification.

#### (3) Certification application process

The workshop provides a step-by-step overview of the MWVE certification application process. Participants learn about the required forms, supporting documents, and information they need to submit. They receive guidance on completing the application accurately and comprehensively.
